 - *d. <u>Approval of Architecture and Engineering Phases for the San Lorenzo</u> <u>Valley High School Wing "B" Science Building Modernization Project</u> (Due to Timeline)Schiermeyer MADI 19-6 Architecture & Planning has been working with the District on the pre-design for the proposed Wing "B" Science Building Modernization project at San Lorenzo Valley High School. They are submitting architecture and engineering fees for the scope of this project based on preliminary cost estimates of construction. *Superintendent's Recommendation: Approve*
 - *e. <u>Approval of Contract for Design Consultant of Wastewater System at</u> <u>San Lorenzo Valley Tri-campus</u> (Due to Timeline)Schiermeyer The wastewater collection, treatment and disposal system at the San Lorenzo Valley Tri-campus has been in dire need of replacement/repair. The Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) for the treatment system requires a 50% reduction in the total nitrogen concentration prior to discharge. Regional Water Quality Control Board records indicate we have not met some of the targeted nitrogen reduction requirements as

well as ongoing exceedances for Total Dissolved Solids (TDS), sodium and chloride. Superintendent's Recommendation: Approve

- *h. <u>Approval of Contract for Roof Repair at SLVHS and SLV Cafeteria</u> (Due to Timeline)......Schiermeyer The District conducted an inspection of all roofs throughout the high school and SLV cafeteria. The District is recommending some repairs to damaged shingles and roof penetrations. Under CUPCCAA, if the contract is under \$60,000, the District can directly negotiate a contract. *Superintendent's Recommendation: Approve*
- *i. <u>Approval of Contract for Quail Hollow Geotechnical Observation and</u> <u>Testing Services</u> (Due to Timeline)Schiermeyer As part of the Quail Hollow Campus Portable Relocation and Site Work project, the District is required to complete geotechnical observations and testing services during construction. The testing services are part of the budgeted "soft costs" of the overall project for Phase I construction. *Superintendent's Recommendation: Approve*


